
Light SE Mask

USER GUIDE

Please ensure you wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use a hand sanitizer with >70% alcohol content before and after removing your AirPop facemask.



1. Unpack the mask and read the instruction leaflet & conditions for use.



2. To adjust the mask, the soft silicone nose bridges (A) and (B) can be extended for larger facial sizes



3. Fit the mask ensuring it covers the nose and mouth area as shown above.



4. Adjust the position of the mask around the nose, chin and cheeks adjusting the ear loops to ensure a secure fit

WARNING

In order to use the mask correctly, it is important that you should follow these instructions.

If you are ill, this mask is unsuitable. Seek advice from the doctor.

- This mask is not a medical device within the scope of Directive 93/42/CEE or Regulation EU/2017/745 (surgical masks) nor is it personal protective equipment in the sense of Regulation EU/2016/425 (respiratory protective devices EN149:2001 FFP2).

- Always check that the mask is correctly fitted and covers the nose, mouth and chin. It is recommended that this mask be worn on bare skin; beards can reduce the filtration efficiency.

- This mask does not replace protective measures (regular hand-washing or social distancing (reduced contact with other people)). It minimizes the projection of respiratory droplets into the environment and provides the wearer with an effective barrier against droplets from others.

WARNING

- Avoid touching your face or adjusting your mask during use.
- This AirPop facemask has passed a hygienic assessment test before leaving the manufacturing facility and there is no requirement to clean it before the first use.
- All outer surfaces of AirPop face mask are impermeable to liquids so your mask can be wiped down with >70% alcohol unscented wipes or a clean paper towel and soap / water solution for at least 20 seconds.
- Allow to dry naturally before each application in a clean and well ventilated container.
- Do not wear your AirPop face mask if it is wet or retains an odour.
- It is recommended to have a supply of between 3 to 5 face masks / coverings so that one can be worn while others are allowed >72 hours to sanitise.

FAQ

Q: How do I know if I am wearing my AirPop face mask correctly?

A: Follow the user guide and check the following: Is the mask off-centre? Are the ear straps too tight? Does the seal fully cover your nose, chin, and cheek? If worn correctly, the user should feel a slight suction effect when breathing in.

Q: When should I change the mask?

A: If cared for and maintained correctly, this AirPop Light SE mask has a proven filtration efficacy capable of >40 hours of cumulative use. Stop using this product at the first signs of damage, or if it becomes dirty / marked or you experience any difficulty when breathing.

Q: How should I store the mask?

A: The AirPop Light mask should be stored in a clean paper or hygienic plastic container with adequate ventilation.

Q: How to dispose the mask?

A: If a mask is damaged or has reached the end of its recommended service life, it can be disposed of with normal waste after cleaning in accordance to the instructions above. It should be disposed of in a bin fitted with a plastic bag (preferably with a lid and non-hand operation). Double bagging is recommended to retain the contents of the first bag in the case of tearing of the outer bag during collection.
